

**Skateboards**

Consistent with the provisions of Title 9, Chapter 19, Section 3(B) of the Corcoran City Code and in accordance with these findings and declarations, and pursuant to the authority vested in the Board of California Education Code Sections 35160, 35160.1, 35161, California Vehicle Code Section 21113 and Corcoran City Council Resolution Number 1442 enacted July 2, 1990, the following Regulations are hereby adopted:

1. Skateboarding is banned from all campuses, driveways, paths, walkways and sidewalks, including all walkways or sidewalks contiguous to each school site, as well as from any other property owned or operated by the Corcoran Joint Unified School District.
2. The District will not tolerate any abuse or damage to school personnel or property as a result of the unauthorized use of skateboards on the property.
3. Pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 21113, the Governing Board authorizes the purchase and placing of signs on all campuses in order to give notice of the above prohibition. This policy shall be kept readily available for public inspection in the District's Administration Office.
4. This policy is applicable to all persons, whether Corcoran Unified students or not, and applies to all hours, whether school is in session or not.
5. In order to enforce this policy, the following rules are adopted:
  - a. Both certificated and classified employees are authorized to stop any person riding a skateboard in unauthorized areas, confiscate the skateboard, and turn it over to the site administrator.
  - b. The status of the offending person shall determine the next course of action:
    - (1) If the offender is a Corcoran Joint Unified student, the penalty for the first infraction will be five (5) days detention in compliance with District disciplinary procedures. Upon completion of detention, the skateboard shall be returned to the student with a warning to refrain from future violations.
    - (2) Upon a second infraction, the student shall be suspended for one (1) day for willful defiance of the valid authority of supervisors, teachers, administrators, officials or school personnel engaged in the performance of their duties. Again, the skateboard will be confiscated and returned to the student upon completion of suspension.
    - (3) Any future infractions will result in an increased suspension of one (1) day for each successive offense up to the statutory maximum for a school year.
    - (4) If the offender is not a Corcoran Joint Unified student, the school officer or employee shall make every reasonable effort to ascertain the person's identity and confiscate the skateboard. However, the employees will not be expected to place themselves in risk of bodily harm to ascertain the offender's identity or to take the skateboard.
    - (5) If the employee is unable to ascertain the offender's identity, local police authorities will be contacted in an effort to alleviate any future trespasses and violations of this policy.
    - (6) If the offender's identity is ascertained, this information and the confiscated skateboard will be forwarded to local police authorities to enforce any ordinances governing skateboarding on public property or trespass upon school grounds. The District shall specifically request that the local police authorities issue citations to those individuals who violate the provisions of this policy.
