

**Transportation**

The major objectives are to provide safe transportation and to operate a system in an efficient and economical manner. Transportation may be furnished as follows:

Kindergarten - 3rd Grade	Residing 3/4 mile from school
4th - 12th Grades	Residing 2 miles from school

Exceptions to these qualifying distances may be approved by the Board.

**Scope of Services**

All distances shall be measured from the gate at the front entrance of the nearest school and by the closest public route over federal, state, county or city maintained roads from the point at which the driveway at the student's residence enters a public road.

Bus routes shall be established by the Director of Transportation according to expedience and safety.

Bus stops shall be recommended by the Director of Transportation, and a list of routes and authorized stops submitted to the Board of Trustees for their approval.

**Fees**

Fees may be charged according to a schedule adopted by the Board.

**Shuttle Bus**

The Corcoran Unified School District has made provisions for supplemental transportation for qualified students. This service is a shuttle bus service which will travel between specific school sites for any student who does not qualify for home to school transportation as outlined above.

The shuttle bus schedule will be distributed to all sites at the beginning of each school year.

All students who wish to use regular and shuttle bus service must carry a bus pass designating them as eligible for the regular service or for shuttle service. These passes may be obtained at the student's school site.

Replacement for missing passes will be provided by the district as a cost to the student of \$1.00.
