1. Students learn best when their emotional needs are met. The first and most important responsibility of the school is to educate and to teach students the necessary attitudes and skills to enable them to live successfully in our community and country.
2. Anything that hinders the teaching/learning process is the concern of the school.

To accomplish the above purposes, psychological service shall be free of charge to students and subject to parent approval.

All persons directly or indirectly concerned with any person receiving psychological services shall handle the relationship in a professional manner.

All information divulged in conversation or case conference reporting shall be regarded as highly confidential.
