

AB 104

Assembly Bill 104

This legislation includes provisions in the area of student retention, pass/no pass grades, and local graduation requirements exemption.

Requirements for Student Retention:

- Students in grades K-11 (2020-2021) who received deficient grades (D, F, or equivalent) in one half of their coursework. Seniors (Class of 2021) are excluded from this provision
- Parents wanting to consult on retention may contact the Educational Services Department, 559-992-8888 or their school site for more information

Requirements for Pass/No Pass Grades:

High School students enrolled in the 2020-2021 school year may request to have a letter grade replaced with a Pass/No Pass. Once the grade change request form is released from the California Department of Education, we will provide the form to families and place it on our website on or after July 31, 2021.

Exemption of Local Graduation Requirements:

In 2020-21, students who were in their 3rd or 4th year of high school and who are not on track to graduate in four years from our district's 260 graduation credit requirements will consult with their academic counselor and be provided with an opportunity to complete the statewide coursework requirements (including a fifth year of instruction or opportunities for credit recovery).
