COVID-19 STUDENT TESTING



COVID Testing Information/ Registration and Consent Form

In an effort to reduce student absences and loss of learning, our Corcoran Unified School District Health Team will be offering on-site COVID-19 testing for students who are exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms or for students who are considered a close contact.

COVID-19 Testing Protocols

- 1. The Corcoran Unified School District Health Team will contact the parent if the child exhibits COVID-19 symptoms.
- 2. Parents will have the opportunity to give permission for the health team to administer and/or facilitate a nasal swab COVID-19 Test.
- 3. If consent is given by the parent for COVID-19 testing, the parent/guardian will register their child with the QR code below. This registration would only have to be done once and not every time the child is tested.
- The site RN or LVN or other trained employee will facilitate the child's selfswabbing in the school office. After collection, the test will be sent for processing.
- 5. If your child is exhibiting symptoms, they will be sent home from school until negative test results are received and/or they have completed the recommended quarantine time.
- 6. If your child has been exposed to a COVID-19 positive individual in the school setting, it is recommended that they test between Day 3 and Day 5 of the last exposure date, or sooner if they become symptomatic. They can remain in school if asymptomatic.
- 7. Once COVID-19 results are received by the parent/guardian, we ask that parents share the results with the school for further direction. If results are from a Home COVID Test, please take a picture of the test results and include the student's name and date of test.
- 8. Parents can take your child for testing at the Annex from 1:30-2:30 pm Monday-Friday. To register your child, point your cell phone camera at this QR code:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
 - Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
 - Nausea or vomiting
 - Diarrhea
